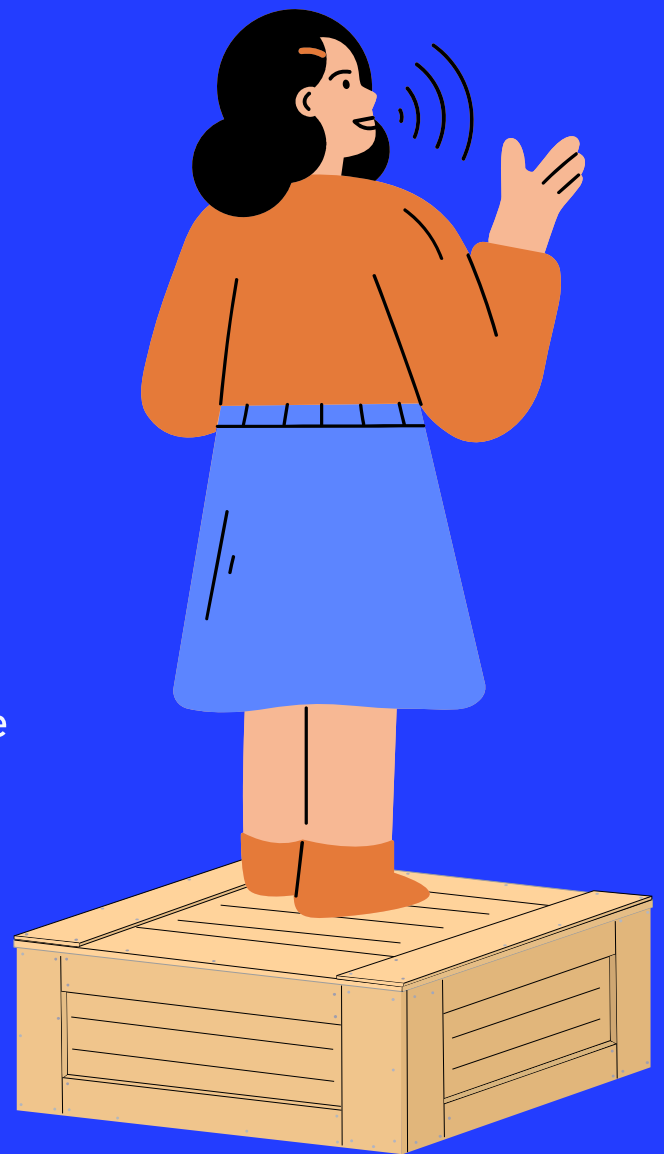
# WANT TO SPREAD positivity?
